Dear Congregation,

Today we received word a person who had worshiped in one of the morning services this Lord's Day attended with symptoms of coronavirus and that person has since received a positive test result. This person was masked the entire time, however a member of that person's household attended both of the services.

For those reasons, Session has decided to suspend in-person Wednesday night activities **this week only**. Symptoms typically develop for Covid-19 within 48-72 hours from exposure (though in rare cases symptoms take up to two weeks to develop). Wednesday night prayer meeting and lesson will be available virtually via the website: <u>www.FPFO.org/live</u>

Our plan at this time is to continue with the Lord's Day schedule without interruption or modification.

While we believe the risk of transmission for *this* case is relatively low, we want to add an extra level of caution because of the contagiousness of this disease and hopefully prevent further interruption of church worship and fellowship activities.

Thank you for your understanding. And as always, **if you or a member of your household has symptoms of sickness, please stay home and join us for the livestream of our activities**. Symptoms of coronavirus include the following:

- New loss of taste or smell
- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea

In light of this situation, if you develop symptoms of Covid-19, we encourage you to get tested as well.

Please continue to pray for the church and especially pray for the family as they care for the sick individual as well as guard their own health.
