



LETTER OF SAINT PAUL TO THE CORINTHIANS 11:23-26

SEQUENCE FOR CORPUS CHRISTI: ECCE PANIS ANGELÓRUM (LAUDE SION)

PLAINCHANT, MODE 7

- 1. Ecce panis Angelórum, Factus cibus viatórum; Vere panis filiórum, Non miténdus cánibus. Behold, the bread of angels has become the food of pilgrims; truly it is the bread of sons and not to be cast to dogs.
- 2. In figures praesignátur, Cum Isáac immolátur, Agnus Paschae deputátur, Datur manna patribus. *It was symbolically prefigured when Isaac was brought as an offering, when a lamb was designated for the Pasch, when manna was given to the fathers.*
- 3. Bone Pastor, panis vere, Jesu, nostril miserere; Tunos pasce, nos tuére, Tu nos bona fac vidére Interra vivéntium. Good Shepherd and true bread, Jesus, have mercy on us; feed us, guard us, grant us to find happiness in the land of the living
- 4. Tuque cuncta scis et vales, Qui nos pascis hic mortáles; Tuos ibi commensáles; Coherédes et sodáles, Fac sanctorum cívium. You know all things and can do all things, you feed us in this life. Make us your guest there (in heaven), co-heirs and companions of the citizens of heaven.




