- o Applicant must obtain a required permit from Marinette County if opening is onto a county road, from the State of Wisconsin if opening is onto a state road or from the Town of Niagara if opening onto a town road.
- o Applicant must provide approved permits from the state or county, if applicable, to the Town Zoning Administrator prior to issuance of a Town Driveway Permit.
