GENERAL RULES					
1. Entries are open to all residents of Boubon County Club Members					
2. One entry per person in each class (including design). A specimen is one stem.					
3. Natural flowers and foliage are permitted					
4. Dried Natural materials are allowed.					
5. Accessories are permitted in all Design Classes.					
6. Exhibits will be received from 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM on Monday, June 27th, 2022. Judging will begin at 1:00 PM by accredited flower show judges. All exhibits are to be removed on Friday, July 1st before 11:00 AM					
7. The judges' decision is final.					
8. Horticulture entries are limited to 12 per person.					
9. All youth exhibits must follow 4-H guidelines. (Refer to page 1)					
10. A specimen must be in a proper container, pop bottle or vase, preferably clear glass and at least 6 inches high. No paper cups or soda cans.					
11. All specimens must be grown from seed or cuttings or immature plants and in exhibitors' possession for at least 60 days. All specimens must be properly identified by the exhibitor.
