Submit original artwork only, no black and white drawings, on white 8 1/2 by 11 inch paper using colored pencil, crayon, markers or paints. If using the color yellow, please use a deep shade or surround it with a dark color. Yellow is hard to reproduce.

Messenger staff members will judge the entries based on the originality and ability to convey what Christmas means to Catholics. Entries must include first and last name, age, grade, home address, school (public, private or home school, with the schools location) and parish (name and city) on the back of the drawing. Please do not fold entries. Any information omitted could disqualify the artwork.
