



<u>Capital Campaign II</u>

The Office of the Capital Campaign of the Diocese required the Pastor and Pastoral/Finance Councils to come up with a "Case for Support" that the 65% (\$78,000) of the capital campaign (the parish share) will be used for.



Over the next 5 years, we would like to:

- Replace the church roof: The roof over our place of worship is over 40 years old. Though we have had only small leaks during some winters, we are using the opportunity of the "Inspired by the Spirit" campaign to address a need before any damage can be done in the future. Estimated cost: \$50,000
- Update electrical fixtures in our worship space: The hanging red fixtures are dated and rather dark. We would like to update these to LED lighting that will beautifully brighten our space. Estimated cost: \$10,000

Stained glass windows: The generic stained glass windows in our worship space will get a facelift with biblical scenes that will use LED lights behind them that would bring in extra light as well as a new focal point for those worshipping in church. Estimated cost: \$18,000

All who own homes know and understand the practicality and the costs of regular maintenance and upkeep. You are also aware that the longer you wait to address these issues, the more costly they may become. St. Joseph Parish is now at a point where we can take a look at these 3 projects of concern. We hope you will be generous in providing for the needs of our parish.
