1) Apologies for absence

2) Minutes from the previous meeting held on Thursday 24th May 2018

3) Matters arising

4) <u>Registration Evening</u>

All attendees were informed that registration for the Winter League 2018/2019 will take place on 11th September at 7.30pm – 8.30pm at Oasis Academy Wintringham, Weelsby Avenue, Grimsby DN32 0AZ.

All existing teams will continue to receive a refund of £80 towards affiliation costs. New teams which have entered the league will be exempt from the £80 refund as stated in the GDSNL Constitution.

a) Fixtures Packs

Fixture packs will be handed out at registration evening, these will consist of fixtures, contact lists and statement of accounts. Teams were asked to be prompt in attending registration evening.

b) Winter League Start Date

Attendees were informed that the GDSNL Winter League will start week commencing 17th September 2018.

5) Presentation Evening

Tracy Barford thanked everyone for attending GDSNL presentation in July and also thanked Johnny Rowan (GTFC) for presenting the trophies. The committee had some great feedback from the booking of the photo booth and cocktail bar and will look forward to organising next years.

6) <u>Promotion & Demotion</u>

Over the summer period three teams have left the league and one new team has joined, Tracy Barford stated that due to 30 teams entering the league for Winter 2018 the divisions would need to be split equally for fixtures. Unfortunately, this does mean that some teams which were promoted stay in the same division and some teams will be demoted. The committee have asked for team secretaries to prepare their teams for this.

Ann-Marie highlighted that a training session will be held on Tuesday 4th September from 6.30pm to 7.30pm and welcomed all netballers to join them so that the juniors could undertake some game play.
