


June Consistory Highlights




We can make our own plans, but the LORD gives the right answer. Prov. 16:1 (MLT)

Christ asks us to see the person and not the action or sin they have done. The person who is convicted of a crime may rightly be incarcerated, but haven't we all done wrong and sinned in God's eyes. No one sin is worse than another in God's eyes it is still sin. I guess we all fall short on the bad side of a badgood list.

Tears from my eyes


