

Streetsville Childrens Centre and Streetsville Academy Reopens.

August 2020.

What changes have you made to enhance Health ?

- We have purchased scrubs for our teaching team that will be worn only at school. They will be laundered on site every day.
- We have sewn cloth masks in the hundredsto be changed many times.
- We have purchased face shields for staff during diaper changes.
- We have sewn ponchos to be used on every diaper change to protect the scrubs and the child from touching the scrubs.
- We have purchased UVC Lights that will be put on in each room at night after everyone leaves and early in the morning before anyone arrives
- No staff can visit other cohorts. Once assign a group they cannot mix or visit
- Hand Wash station has been added to the NS3 room for frequent hand washes.

What will the classrooms look like ?

- Each cohort of 8 will be with 2 consistent staff.
- Each child will have his /her own bin of toys, arts and teaching kits.
- All children's designated spaces will be as much as possible be 6 feet apart
- Each room will have a hand sanitizer station for frequent use.
- A very comprehensive school schedule will be strictly followed.
- Each cohort will have a float staff to cover breaks and clean the room while the cohort is outside.

Food Service .

- We will be serving Brown Bag lunches supplied by Wholesome Kids our caterer. This will be a no touch drop off at the centre
- All diet requirements will be followed

- No food will be allowed in the building from home
- Snacks will be individually portioned and served at the child's station.

Staff .

All staff will return to their regular rooms.

Until we have confirmed children its hard to know if we will have more preschool than toddler or more JK than preschool . We will use the rooms for whatever we need and as numbers increase then spread them into the right rooms. For sure we have all aged !

No more baby babies so we start again and build together. We are all in this together the staff have been great and have helped to reorganize rooms .

Sick room.

- We have a designated room for anyone who appears to be sick.
- This will be staffed by a teacher until the child leaves then completely deep cleaned

Cleaning .

- Before re opening we will be doing a deep clean.
- Every morning 7.30-8 am cleaning will take place and safety meeting .
- Every evening 5-6pm staff will deep clean all children must be picked up by 5pm
- One adult is assigned to each cohort to relieve breaks , lunch and clean
- One adult is assigned to HIGH touch areas all day long including washrooms.

Marshalls

- We will have 2 Marshalls on duty all day LUCY AND EMMA .
- Their job is to monitor the children arriving and ensure the safety of the staff and children all day at school
- They will restrict access from visitors and non essential services.
- They will support and encourage the staff in programming
- They will monitor the systems in place and adjust if necessary
- They have the authority to make decisions daily to ensure the well being of the staff and the children.

Communcation

- Marshalls will let you know on the SEE saw app and by photographs how things are going.
- Telephone chats will be organized by the Marshalls to touch base with parents regularly

Training

- During Covid our staff have taken hours and hours of Professional Development.
- We will run a safety meeting every day at start of shift to remind staff of hand washing, important reminders and schedules .
- Staff have been on training workshops and watched videos in readiness for opening as directed by Peel Health , Ministry of Education and Region of Peel.
- Marshalls have taken extensive training managing the site in reopening
- We have had weekly staff meetings with our team to be in constant contact

What to bring to school.

- We do not want you to bring a backpack or anything from home
- Please bring a sunscreen to school labeled . We can not accept sprays or the following Aveeno, Neutrogena or Banana Boat
- Please bring a labeled SUN HAT to keep at school
- Diapers and wipes must be a NEW unopened package
