Fr. Gus' Corner

I. Musings

I went in for surgery early morning of May 4 to repair the rotator cuff on my right shoulder. Due to amazing medical advancements, by twelve thirty, I was back home where I was attended to and cared for by the staff and a cousin of mine who came from Gaithersburg, Maryland.

I was in terrible pain, dizzy and wasn't fully aware of my bearings on that day, but with pain killers, care and rest, I started on my road to recovery, supported by the fervent prayers of all parishioners of Galloway and Bevent. Thank you for the cards of "Get Well" wishes.

II. I am into my second week of therapy (3 times per week) and it's going ok, but pain medications are "coming to my aid" after sessions.

On Tuesday, May 3, after the public mass at Bevent, a parishioner wished me well for the next day's surgery, among everyone at the mass. She said, "Heal fast and well! They can do lots of things but they cannot do all the things—some things can only be done by me," she ended. We laughed over it but I told her, "I'll keep that in mind, for it is true." And it's always on my mind!

III. Please, all know that I'm ready, willing and eager to return to ministry (job/work) but like all of us, too, we "listen" to doctors. I go in on May 19 to see the doctor.

This past Sunday, May 15, the Bishop William Callahan and Father Woody Page, the Vicar for Clergy of the Diocese, visited me in Galloway and spent about an hour with me, prayed and blessed me. It really made my day and changed my "mourning into dancing" (Psalm 30). As part of conversation, the Bishop asked if I've told my parents in Ghana that "Here am I in America suffering..." to which we all laughed. On a serious note, I told him, "Nope, Bishop. I don't share that with them. They are 83 and 80. I count on their daily prayers, but nope, I won't share my fall, surgery, etc. with them."

IV. To conclude, please keep praying for me and know that I do pray for you, too. Musing on difficulty of getting help (priests), I'm willing and eager to return to work. At Bevent over the past weekend, there were 4 different ministers for 3 sacraments: Holy Masses (2 different priests); Baptism (different Deacon) and Wedding (another Deacon). All of this (need for quick recovery) means I long to be back to do my work and some pains are a part of my "musings".
