


Sleep well dear guest

This pattern is a replica of a vintage cross-stitched poem, the embroidery is quite large and was at one time framed.

The original was stitched on loose evenweave, and features a poem written by **Ellen Maria Huntington Gates** (1835–1920).



Design Area: 191 x 133 stitches

If stitched on 28 ct linen/14 ct aida the pattern will measure :

13,64" x 9,5" / 34,6 x 24 cm

On 28 ct linen use two strands of embroidery floss for the cross stitch.

<u>Tips</u>

This pattern would make a lovely cushion for your guest room, you can either stitch it in tent stitch on canvas, or in cross stitch on aida. Sew the canvas or aida into a cushion cover using the backing of your choice, or recycle older cover by carefully taking it apart and replacing the from panel with your embroidery.
