Tetrad Guide: TR13 X

(Seabrook, Sandgate West and Shorncliffe)



Introduction

The tetrad TR13 X contains a section of coastline (which includes a rock groyne at Battery Point), the easternmost end of the Royal Military Canal, Paraker Wood and the adjoining southern part of the Dibgate plain, a wooded area between Horn Street and Shorncliffe Camp, and the residential areas of Seabrook, western Sandgate and south-west Cheriton. The Seabrook Stream runs through the tetrad and discharges into the canal.

Habitats and birds

The beach often holds roost of gulls and, in season, terns and these may attract occasionally rarer species visitors like Iceland, Caspian or Yellow-legged Gull, and even a Forster's Tern in November 2016 (the second county record). There are often divers, grebes, ducks and auks in the bay, whilst spring sees an up-channel passage of wildfowl, waders, skuas and terns. Unusual species have included White-fronted Goose, Bewick's Swan, Egyptian Goose, Eider, Velvet Scoter, Red-necked, Black-necked and Slavonian Grebes, Avocet, Black-tailed Godwit, Grey Phalarope, Sabine's Gull, Little Gull, Little Tern, Black Tern, Pomarine Skua, Little Auk, Great Northern Diver, Sooty Shearwater and Spoonbill. The rock groyne at Battery Point may hold a small number of Purple Sandpipers between late October and early May.

The Royal Military Canal comes to its easternmost end in TR13 X and, as with the other tetrads which it crosses, this provides a particularly interesting habitat for birds. The canal itself holds breeding Mute Swan, Mallard and Moorhen, whilst scarcer visitors have included Mandarin Duck, Gadwall, Pochard, Scaup, Goldeneye, Goosander, Red-breasted Merganser, Black-necked Grebe, Red-throated and Great Northern Divers and Night Heron. Reed Warblers breed in the *Phragmites* along the canal edges, whilst the scrub and trees which line the bank hold breeding Cetti's Warbler and Reed Bunting. Chiffchaff, Blackcap and Firecrest may overwinter, when Kingfishers and Water Rails can also be seen regularly along the canal.

Paraker Wood hosts a typical range of woodland species, including Stock Dove, Tawny Owl, Green and Great Spotted Woodpecker, Goldcrest, Coal Tit, Marsh Tit and Bullfinch. The semi-natural mixed and broadleaved woodland (dominated by sycamore) and scrubland between Horn Street and Shorncliffe Camp has attracted some interesting species and could repay attention in the migration seasons, particularly around the Sandy Lane area. Woodcock, Firecrest, Ring Ouzel, Nightingale, Yellow-browed Warbler and Wood Warbler have been noted on passage, whilst a wintering Pallas's Warbler was found at the northern end of the area in January 2014 (also roaming into TR13 Y) and a Greenish Warbler was seen to the south of Sandy Lane at Pemberton Court in September 2017.

It is suspected that Hobbies breed in the vicinity of the Horn Street valley and a pair of Grey Wagtails often breed where the Seabrook Stream meets the canal. There was formerly a lake adjacent to Horn Street, which had attracted Garganey and Water Rail, but this has since silted up, though Siskins sometimes winter along the stream here.

Overflying raptors have included Honey Buzzard, Black and Red Kites, Osprey and Marsh and Montagu's Harriers, whilst of most note amongst the other oddities are records of Common Crane, Ruff, Short-eared Owl, Ring-necked Parakeet, Nightjar, Hoopoe, Wood Lark, Waxwing, Richard's Pipit and Hawfinch.



Access and parking

There is free parking along the A259 Sandgate Esplanade but Princes Parade is a pay and display zone between 1st April and 30th September (and free at other times). These roads provide good vantage points from which to view the bay and enable easy access to the beach. There is a wooden shelter (a former tram stop) on the seafront (near the footbridge over the canal) which may be used as a seawatching point as it offers some protection from the weather. The canal is flanked by footpaths on both sides which continue in to TR13 S.

Several footpaths/bridleways cross the area of wood and scrubland between Horn Street and Shorncliffe Camp and the Paraker Wood area has rights of way that link with TR13 S and TR13 Y. The main bus route between Folkestone and Hythe passes along the A259.

Bird species diversity

The tetrad held an average number of breeding species in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork but due to the presence of coast and canal it ranked fourth richest amongst the 31 local tetrads for the variety of wintering species and has the fifth highest overall species total, as the table below demonstrates.

Other Natural History

The tetrad has an impressive and growing moth list due to the residency of Ade Jupp at Seabrook between 2012 and 2016 and Paul Howe at Seabrook from January 2016. Almost 1,000 species have been recorded, which is the second highest amongst the local tetrads, and have included a rich array of rare and notable species.

Numerous species have been added to the area list, including the first county records of *Caloptilia hemidactylella* (Sycamore Slender) and *Pammene ignorata* (Devon Piercer), the sixth British record of Banded Pine Carpet and the fourth Kent record of *Etiella zinckenella* (Legume Knot-horn).

Other species recorded here for the first time have included *Lyonetia prunifoliella* (Striped Bent-wing), *Gelechia muscosella* (Grey Sallow Groundling), *Scrobipalpa salicorniae* (Sea-aster Groundling), *Elachista maculicerusella* (Triple-spot Dwarf), *Gravitarmata margarotana* (Pine Cone Tortrix), *Aphomia zelleri* (Twin-spot Honey), *Loxostege sticticalis* (Diamond-spot Pearl), Raspberry Clearwing, Pinion-spotted Pug, Portland Ribbon Wave and Oak Rustic.

The first modern occurrences of *Narycia duplicella* (White-speckled Bagworm), *Hellinsia lienigianus* (Mugwort Plume), Lunar Hornet Moth, Bedstraw Hawk-moth, Broom-tip, September Thorn and Light Crimson Underwing and the second area records of *Caloptilia honoratella* (Pale Maple Slender), *Thaumatotibia leucotreta* (False Codling Moth), *Sciota hostilis* (Scarce Aspen Knot-horn), *Acrobasis tumidana* (Scarce Oak Knot-horn), *Ephestia kuehniella* (Mediterranean Flour Moth), *Hellula undalis* (Old World Webworm), Dark Tussock, the Passenger, Double Kidney and Shore Wainscot and the second modern record of Scarce Chocolate-tip have also been noted.

Other species of particular note have included *Zelleria oleastrella* (Olive Ermel), *Ocnerostoma friesei* (Grey Pine Ermel), *Tebenna micalis* (Vagrant Twitcher), *Acleris permutana* (Buff Button), Oak Lutestring, Blair's Mocha, Grass Rivulet, the Streak, Beautiful Marbled, Clifden Nonpareil, Dark Crimson Underwing, Dewick's Plusia, Silver Hook, Star-wort, Porter's Rustic, Dotted Chestnut, Splendid Brocade, Blossom Underwing and Radford's Flame Shoulder.

The more regular immigrants have included *Cydia amplana* (Vagrant Piercer), *Palpita vitrealis* (Olive-tree Pearl), Convolvulus Hawk-moth, Dusky Hook-tip, the Vestal, the Gem, Golden Twin-spot, Bordered Straw, Scarce Bordered Straw, the Delicate, White-speck and Small Mottled Willow.

Amongst the other notable migrants or wanderers, occurrences of Oblique Striped, Barred Tooth-striped, White-banded Carpet, Rest Harrow, Sussex Emerald, Blotched Emerald, Dotted Footman and Double Lobed are of particular note.

Notable butterfly records have included a Swallowtail in 2014, a Grayling in 2018 and a Silver-washed Fritillary in 2022, whilst Clouded Yellows are regularly recorded. White-letter Hairstreak may be found on Wych Elm along the canal and Purple Hairstreak has been found at Sandy Lane.

The first county record of the **Large Conehead** Bush-cricket was attracted to light at Seabrook on the 13th August 2020 and the recent colonist. Rambur's Pied Shieldbug has been found along the canal banks. Southern Hawker, Brown Hawker, Migrant Hawker, Hairy Dragonfly and Four-spotted Chaser have been recorded but with part of the Royal Military Canal being found within the tetrad, there is potential to considerably extend the odonata list. Grey Seal, Common Seal, Harbour Porpoise and Common Bottlenose Dolphin have been noted offshore, whilst a Minke Whale was seen in December 2022.

General History

TR13 X, like several other coastal tetrads in this 10km square, is heavily influenced by the impending threat of invasion from Napoleonic France in the early nineteenth century. The position and topography of Shorncliffe as a flat site overlooking the Channel gave it strategic importance for military defence of the south coast and an army camp was first established in 1794 following purchase of over 229 acres of land by the British Army.

The Old Redoubt, a Napoleonic earthwork c.300ft by 300ft in size, was constructed at this time to provide additional defence of the bay below and Martello Towers plus other fortifications that were subsequently erected along the coastline for this purpose. It ceased to be used as a military fortification in 1855 and is now primarily covered in scrub and trees. It has been designated as a Scheduled Monument.

Shorncliffe Camp's use as a temporary/seasonal training camp for Light Infantry was begun by Sir John Moore in 1803 until, during the Crimean War in the mid-19th century, it was developed into a permanent training ground. It continued to develop throughout the 19th and 20th century with the replacement of temporary cabins and tents and is still used and owned by the Ministry of Defence.

The tetrad contains three Martello Towers, numbered 7 to 9 of the 74 which were built (and are listed sequentially) along the coastline between Folkestone (1) and Seaford, Sussex (74). Number 7 is in poor condition and has been sealed to prevent access but can be seen from the footpath inland from Sandgate; number 8, located at the junction of Hospital Hill and Upper Corniche, has been converted into a private residence, whilst number 9, situated near Sandy Lane, is in a fair state of preservation, with most of the stucco in place, and the ditch brickwork in good order.

The easternmost end of a further development from the Napoleonic era, the Royal Military Canal, is within TR13 X. The canal is a coastal defence work that was constructed between 1804 and 1809 and its purpose was to separate the expected landing and deployment of Napoleon's troops upon the coast of Romney Marsh from the interior of the country and was the idea of Lt. Col. Brown, the Assistant Quartermaster-General.

The canal runs a total of about 28 miles from Seabrook via Hythe, inland to Appledore, then to join the Eastern River Rother at Iden lock, from where it became part of first the Rother and then the River Brede, turning into a canal again from Winchelsea to Cliff End on the coast. Excavated earth formed the banquette and parapet on the landward side of the canal and behind this was an army supply route, the Royal Military Road. On the opposite side were the tow path and wharves. It also included a back and a front drain. The canal and parapets were so built that gun positions could be provided at the end of each length to flank the crossings. However, by the time the canal was completed in 1809, the threat of invasion had passed following Napoleon's defeat at the Battle of Trafalgar, and it was to some extent obsolete. In 1810, the canal was opened for public use and tolls were also collected for use of the Royal Military Road.

The area between Shorncliffe Camp and Horn Street was used for the purpose of training soldiers during the First World War, primarily in trench excavation and warfare. Extensive practice trenches remain in the area today as well as a number of other small defensive features including several pillboxes. Also of interest in the Shorncliffe Military Cemetery, near Sandy Lane, which contains the remains of British, Canadian and other Foreign National soldiers from both World Wars.

Mill House, situated towards the southern end of Horn Street, dates from the early nineteenth century and is grade II listed, whilst the western part of Sandgate contains several grade II properties built primarily in the eighteenth or early nineteenth century. A tram railway formerly ran along Princes Parade and a tram shelter remains to this day.
