These self-governed library banks act as a secure foundation on which to build local regenerative enterprises and collaboratives, connecting people who are passionate contributors to individual

health and wellbeing and the thrivability of the community as a whole.

SaSi is an invitation to co-create an open-source regenerative project, locally managed and globally connected through the SEEDS ecosystem, for the propagation and mindful sharing of spores and seeds and the many diverse and fruitful harvests and rewards it brings.

Market value to valued markets

The global mushroom market size was valued at \$46.1 billion in 2020 and is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate of 9.5% from 2021 to 2028, reaching nearly \$87.5 billion. <u>Source</u>

The global vegetable seeds market was valued at \$5.78 billion in 2019 and is projected to reach \$10.48 billion by 2027. *Source*

We have the technology and practical tools available today, that make it possible to redirect a significant portion of these market valuations into building local regenerative microeconomies with decentralised spore and seed libraries and banks.

We also have the technology, tools and human capital available to co-create regenerative spore and seed opportunities, that are capable of contributing to the development of flourishing and prosperous local economies and regenerative ecological environments, in collaboration with eco-conscious farmers and consumers.
