Pastor's Pen

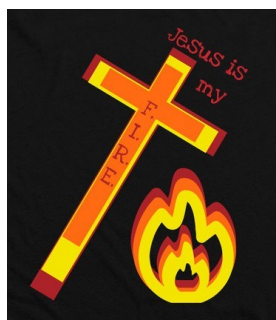


Greetings Family of God,

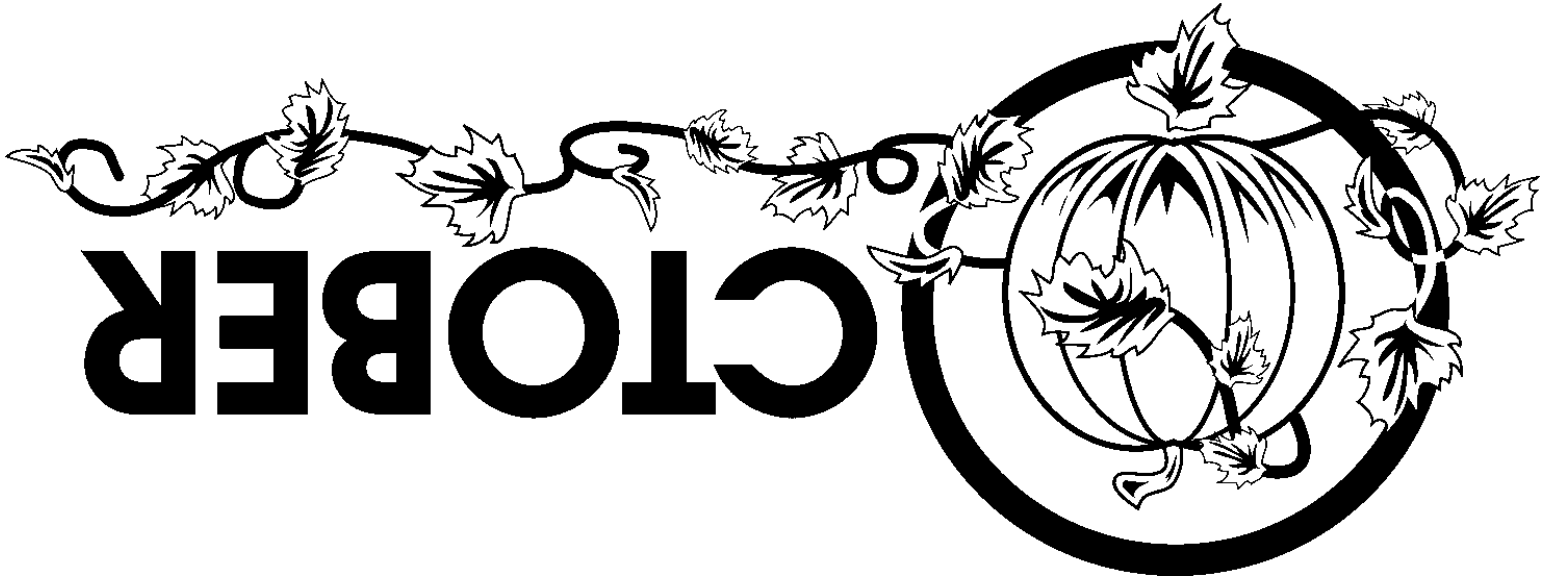
