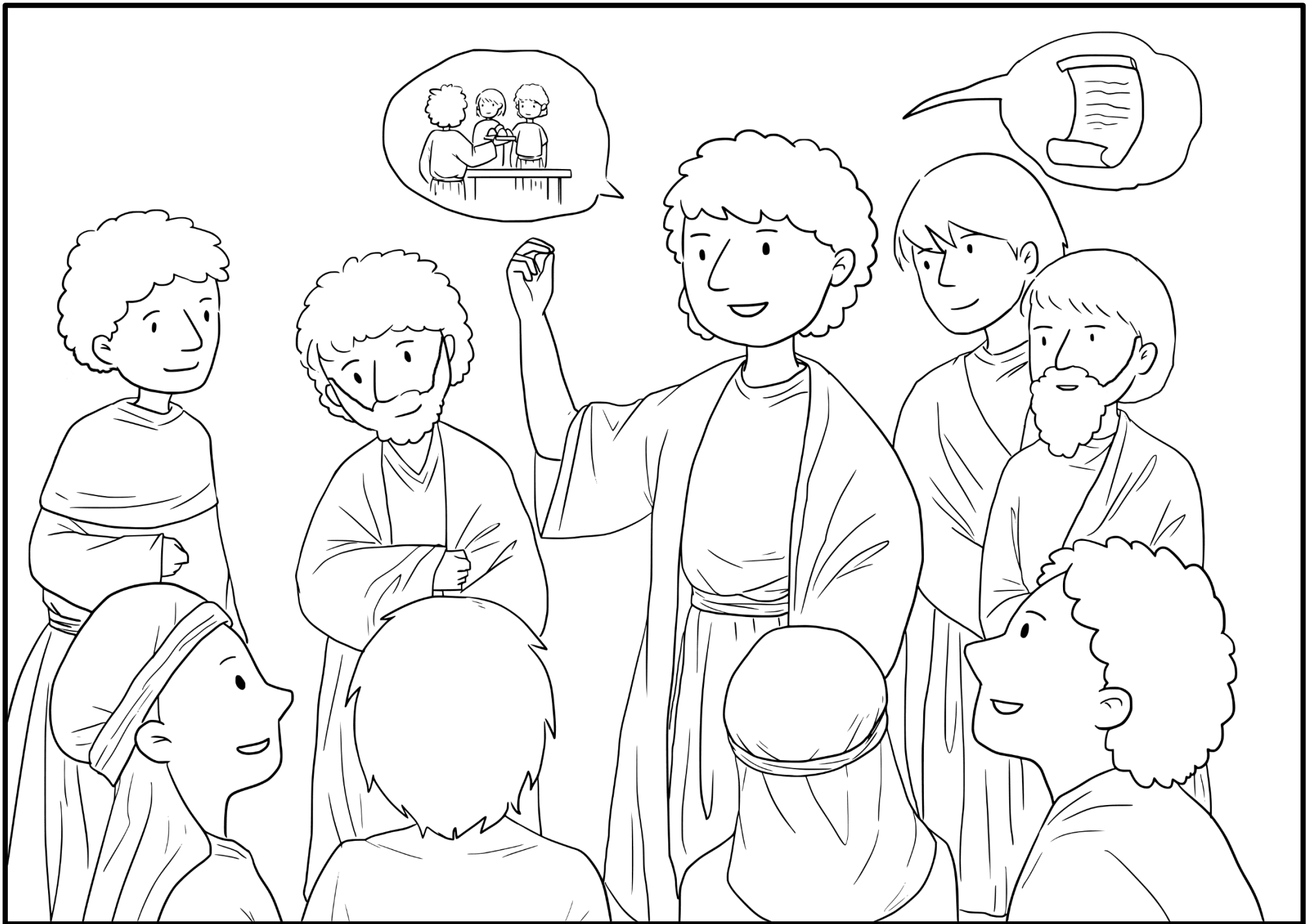

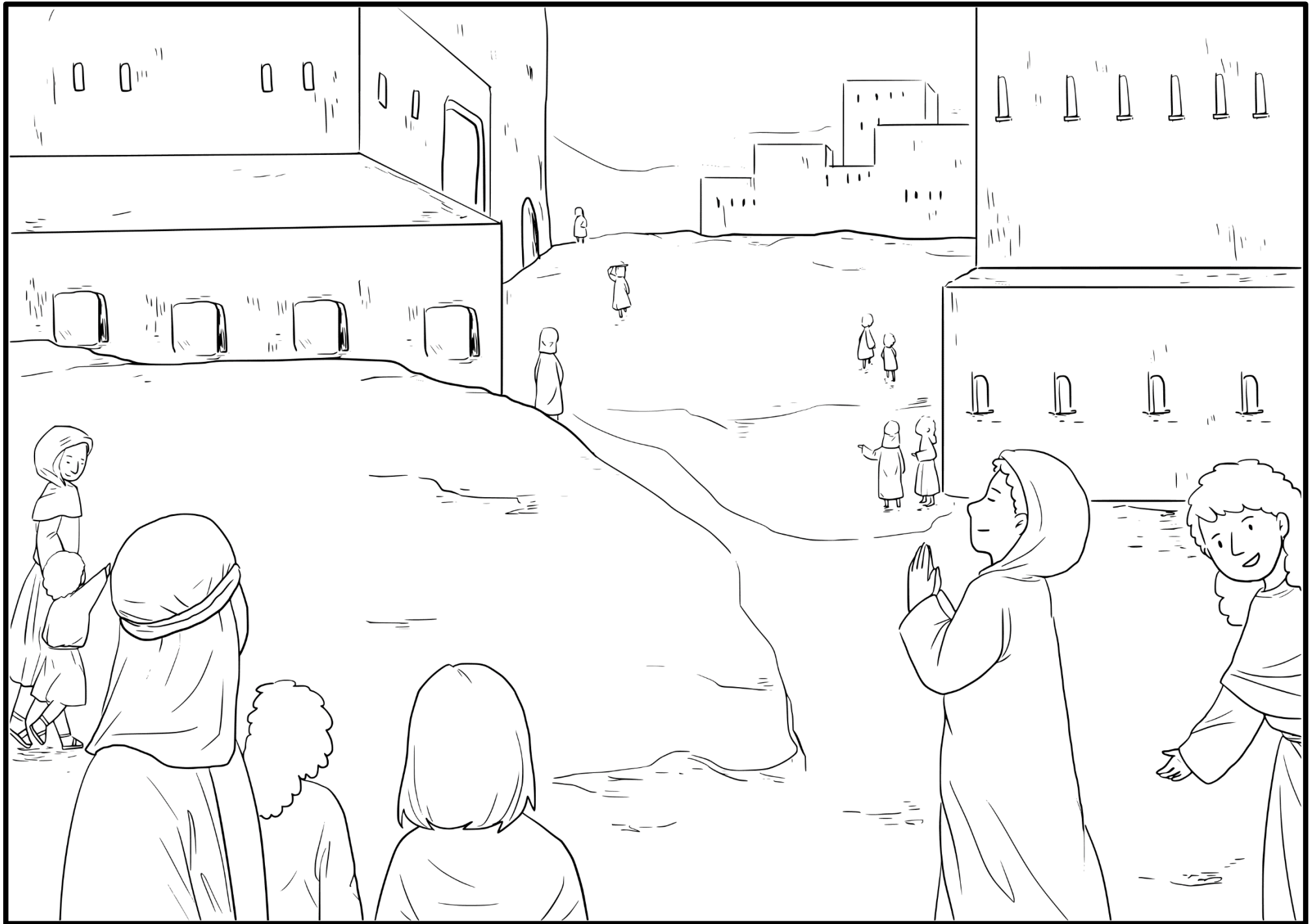


And having called near the assembly of the disciples, the twelve said, it is not good that we should neglect
