IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All Pintos must be fit & well for at least the week prior to the event & must not be brought to the event if they are unwell. Any expenses caused by any biosecurity breach which causes a shutdown of the event will be the responsibility of the person in charge of the pintos at the event. Q.P.H.A. Inc. will not be responsible for any costs involved in a shutdown.
- Horse health declarations must be handed in for ALL horses/ponies, whether they are competing or not. Horse Health Declarations must be handed to a committee member before your stables will be unlocked if you are stabling, otherwise they must be handed in to receive your competitors pack which contains your bridle number. Arrival & Departure times of all horses/ponies must be noted on our record sheet at the office. Please stop on your arrival and departure and write your time and sign beside your horses name at the office.
- Hendra Vaccination is not compulsory to compete. If vaccinated please include copy of current certificate with entries. We will have vets able to be called to the grounds in an emergency but it is the vets decision if they treat a non-Hendra vaccinated horse/pony.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU READ ALL YOUR FORMS AND THAT THEY ARE FILLED OUT CORRECTLY WITH ALL INFORMATION. Entries will only be accepted if completed on our nomination forms, not in any other way.
- Entries close 6pm 16/9/2022. Last mail to be received by the 16th. NO new late entry exhibits, MUST be pre nominated. No correspondence regarding entries will be available via any committee member between the 20/9/22 and the 30/9/22 inclusive. We will acknowledge receipt of entries and that all is correct when we receive them. If you do not get an acknowledgment, but have sent your entries in, please contact us by 6pm on the 16th September 2022 to follow this up.
- Pre nominated Pintos can enter additional classes at the late entry fee on the day only excluding futurities and dressage. Late entry fee is \$10 QPHA members \$15 non members and must be done at least 1 hour prior the class.
- We have limited cash in the office, please bring small notes and coins if possible for late entries and raffle tickets.
- Stable refund is only available if your stable is signed off clean by inspection with a committee member before you leave. Also please ensure your bank details are included on the nomination form if you are stabling as all refunds will be paid by direct deposit back into your account.
- Bridle number refunds will be given to you once you finish competing when you return your bridle number to the office.
- Dressage will be run in one ring only, competitors to present to judge advising name and test they have entered and judge will gear check prior your test. Dressage will be open during the hack and hunter classes, For example please take advantage of when the ponies are competing to take your hack to do your test.
- Any Children under the age of 13 must be supervised by an Adult not handling a horse 18 years and over at all times.
- If dogs are on the grounds at any stage they MUST be on a lead at all times or in a crate/cage. They are not allowed near the horse areas at all, unless they are assistance/guide dogs and approved by QPHA Inc committee
- Please be aware sound maybe heard from the local gun club firing during the weekend

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program if necessary. Classes may be combined or judged at the same time if there are insufficient entries in any classes.
2. All exhibits MUST be adult registered or foal recorded with a recognised incorporated pinto association in Australia. Photocopy of registration papers MUST be provided if NOT registered with the QPHA Inc.
3. All owners of exhibits entered to compete MUST be financial members with their respective pinto association. Photocopy of membership MUST be provided if NOT a QPHA Inc. member.
4. The QPHA Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to livestock, person or property of any owner, competitor or assistant. Each participant by the act of their entry waives all claims on the QPHA Inc. and its members.
5. Any person that harasses a Judge or Steward shall be deemed guilty of unseemly conduct and may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
6. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to measure any pinto competing in classes with height stipulations.
7. Protests must be made in writing, accompanied by \$50.00 cash and be in the hands of a member of the show committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the class concerned. Should the grounds for protest be considered frivolous, this money will be forfeited.
8. All competitors in ridden sporting events must wear an approved safety helmet.
9. All persons in the ring must wear appropriate footwear and headgear. All handlers and riders aged 17 years and under must wear an approved safety helmet at all times when leading pintos and mounted (including western).
10. All pintos entered that are not registered with QPHA Inc. MUST comply with QPHA Inc. Colour and Breed requirements.
11. Animal welfare rules apply to this event as per EA/HSAA regulations. Any handler that mistreats his/her pinto may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
12. If behaviour of a pinto is deemed to be dangerous a judge/steward or QPHA Inc committee member will ask the handler/rider to leave the ring with that pinto and QPHA Inc committee will assess if safe to continue in anymore classes at the show or not.
13. Insurance regulations require that ALL exhibitors and riders who are NOT members with the QPHA Inc, must pay day insurance of \$20 and sign a disclaimer to be able to compete. Please provide proof of membership.
14. There will be NO deviation from the rules including dress attire and equipment for pintos.

15. Lead Line & Walk & Trot classes - Riders that compete in lead line classes cannot compete in walk & trot classes. Riders that compete in lead line or walk & trot cannot compete in any other ridden classes except classes that specify lead line or walk & trot, Smartest on Parade, Fancy Dress and the Walk/trot dressage test for walk & trot riders. They can be ridden in either English, Western or Australian Stock Horse attire but not a combination of both. If competing in other ridden classes during the show you cannot compete in the Lead Line/Assisted/Walk Trot classes.
16. Age of Pinto - Regardless of when your pinto is born the age shall be calculated on the basis of a year commencing of the 1st day of August of the breeding season that it is foaled.
17. Pinto Age for Saddle Classes - Pintos entered in saddle classes must be 3 years old or older. 3 year olds are only allowed to enter a maximum of 4 ridden classes.
18. Stallion/Colt any height - Are allowed to be shown in halter/led classes and all ridden classes where applicable by an Adult 18 years and over only. Stallion must be under the control of a competent handler/rider at all times. No stallion/colt in youth classes. Stallions/Colts 2 years and over must display green bridle/halter disc or green number holder.
19. Youth Age - 17 years and under at date of show
20. Amateur Owner - An amateur is any person who is no longer eligible to show in youth classes (18 years and over) and has not been a professional in the horse industry for the last three years. Competitors wishing to enter Amateur classes MUST produce a current Membership Card with Amateur Owner listed on it.
21. Veteran classes – These are for Pintos 16 years and over, you can only enter the one age/height class, so cannot enter a height class eg Mare 14hh-15hh and then also enter the Veteran mare class exc 14hh. The winner of the Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Champion of their section eg. Champion Pinto Mare exc 14hh.

22. QPHA in line with EA and FEI will be implementing the recent FEI rule to ban the trimming of horse sensory hairs across all disciplines in the interests of horse welfare. At the 2020 FEI General Assembly, a new rule that prohibits the clipping/shaving of sensory hairs was passed as part of the veterinary regulations, which came into effect on 1st July 2021. Vibrissae, or sensory hairs/whiskers, are the long stiff hairs growing on the chin, mouth and around the eyes and are used as organs of touch by the horse. There will be a transition period from now until 1st January 2023, when the rule will come into full effect. No elimination or penalty will be incurred during the transition period for either presentation.

Open Performance Led & Leadline Classes

English, Western & Australian Stockhorse Attire (abbreviated after classes E, W or S) depending on attire required. Open Performance Western Classes will be judged as a western event whether the rider/horse is in Western or Australian Stockhorse attire.

PLEASE NOTE – For Handler classes – Attire can be E, W or S. English should be Jodphurs, riding jacket etc as per English riding attire BUT we will allow Non English riders who wish to compete in Handler classes to wear trousers, long sleeved collared shirt and hat/helmet suitable for English in hand led classes.
