The Month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. According to an account by fifteenth-century Dominican, Alan de la Roch, Mary appeared to St. Dominic in 1206, after he had been praying and

doing severe penances because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. The Blessed Virgin Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon. She explained its uses and efficacy, and she told him to preach it to others. "Since the prayers of the Rosary come from such excellent sources — from Our Lord Himself, from inspired Scripture, and from the Church, it is not surprising that the Rosary is so dear to our Blessed Mother and so powerful with heaven." The church invites each one of us to pray the Rosary during this beautiful month of October, and it encourages us to become an Apostle of Holy Rosary.
