Orientation: During this phase, the individual has a felt need and seeks professional assistance. Resolution The patient gradually puts aside old goals and adopts new goals. This is a process in which the patient frees himself from identification with the nurse. In Nursing Process, the orientation phase parallels with assessment phase where both the patient and nurse are strangers; meeting initiated by patient who expresses a felt need. Conjointly, the nurse and patient work together, clarifies and gathers important information. Based on this assessment the nursing diagnoses are formulated, outcome and goal set. The interventions are planned, carried out and evaluation done based on mutually established expected behaviours.
