- Q. Why is the body of our Lord represented by the bread and the blood with wine?
- A. As bread has the power of nourishing our bodies to sustain the present life so the same power is in the body of our Lord for the spiritual nourishment of our souls. And as with wine the hearts of men are cheered, their powers renewed, and the whole body strengthened, so from the blood of Christ the same benefits are to be received by our souls through faith.

God Calls Us to Repentance:

1 John 1:7-9

The blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

God's People Confess Their Sin

Almighty Father, while we were yet sinners, You sent Your Son to bear our sins in His body on the tree. And while we know this and have been reminded of this glorious truth many times, we continue to act as infants in Christ. We behave as if we were still in the flesh. have built us into Your holy temple. You have promised us that we have conquered death in the death of our Savior. And so we confess all of these things, as well as more sins beside, and we do so in the confidence that You will hear and forgive, for the sake of Your Son our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.


