Dear brothers and sisters,

In this last days, we have been listening a lot the word unity, that we need to unify in front of a divided nation. Also, that we need to unify to combat COVID-19. I wanted to reflect a little bit on the word unity. The word unity comes from the Latin unus that means one; the definition then comes to be "to be one". To be one is not the same as to be the same.
