## TOP YIELD & EARLY HARVEST

### Cob Ripeness



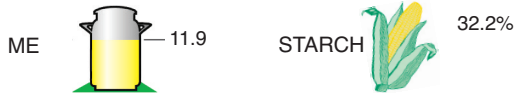
Large well filled determinate cobs with early dent grain and good maturity, similar to Ambition.  
Cob ripening days after Picker + 8.

### Maturity Group



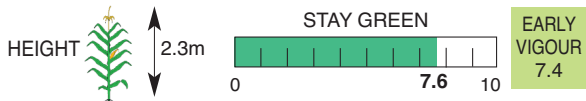
Bonnie is a maturity class 8 variety for the main bulk of maize growers. Its early cob ripeness allows high yields of forage to be achieved even in areas with less heat units.

### Quality & Digestibility



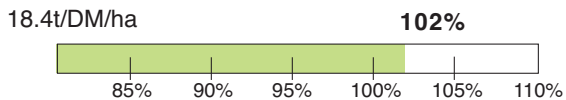
Very high digestibility and cell wall digestibility 61.1% combine with good starch to produce superb silage.

### Plant Description



Excellent early vigour and early season growth. Medium plant height with low cob attachment. Good Eyespot resistance of 5.9.

### Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. Very high yields of forage in NIAB trials. Excellent combination of cob and plant yield to form quality forage in the clamp.
