God Calls Us to Repentance

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! (Romans 6:12-15)

Please forgive us and renew us in the knowledge of Your Son so that we can powerfully turn away from sin and endeavor after righteous living for the sake of Christ our Covenant Redeemer.


*Next Sunday (**August 18**) during Sunday school, the young people will be presenting a report on their retreat in the Smoky Mountains.
