Fall Worship Schedule: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will continue worshipping outside as long as possible, continuing with one service at 9:30am even into the fall. Our worship and music committee and the church council will continue to monitor the situation and plan for colder weather.

Outdoor Worship: We are holding worship at 9:30am on the front lawn outside Luther Hall. Masks are required while moving to and from seats, and while ushers distribute communion. They are strongly recommended while seated. Please maintain a 6-foot physical distance from those outside your household. Please bring a lawn chair. If you are unable, some chairs will be provided. One canopy tent has arrived to help block the sun, and another one will hopefully arrive soon. In the event of inclement weather, we will not gather in person for worship. The worship leaders will record the service, and it will be posted online on Sunday afternoon.
