STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Niagara Marinette County Per §349.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes ORDINANCE #2010-4-C

The Town Board of the Town of Niagara, Marinette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. <u>349.11</u>, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. <u>349.11</u>, Wis. stats., effective October 22, 2013 speed limits on certain Town of Niagara town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Timothy, Carpenter, and Bomber Roads to 25 miles per hour.

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on October 22, 2012 with the publication and posting of the ordinance and proper signage erected on site.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. $\underline{60.80}$, Wis. stats.
