Directions to Brookwood

5604 Swan Creek Drive, Toledo

The Brookwood Area is a Metroparks facility in a S. Toledo neighborhood, at the end of Swan Creek Drive. (Note that some GPS apps may not be accurate for this location.)

- From Southwyck Blvd, turn right onto Brownstone Blvd., left onto Cresthaven Lane, and right onto Swan Creek Drive. Continue to the entrance
- ♦ From Reynolds Road, turn onto Brownstone Blvd., right onto Cresthaven Lane and right onto Swan Creek Drive
- ♦ From Heatherdowns: Turn north onto Plum Leaf Lane and follow Plum Leaf until it curves into Swan Creek Drive. Brookwood will be on your left at the curve
