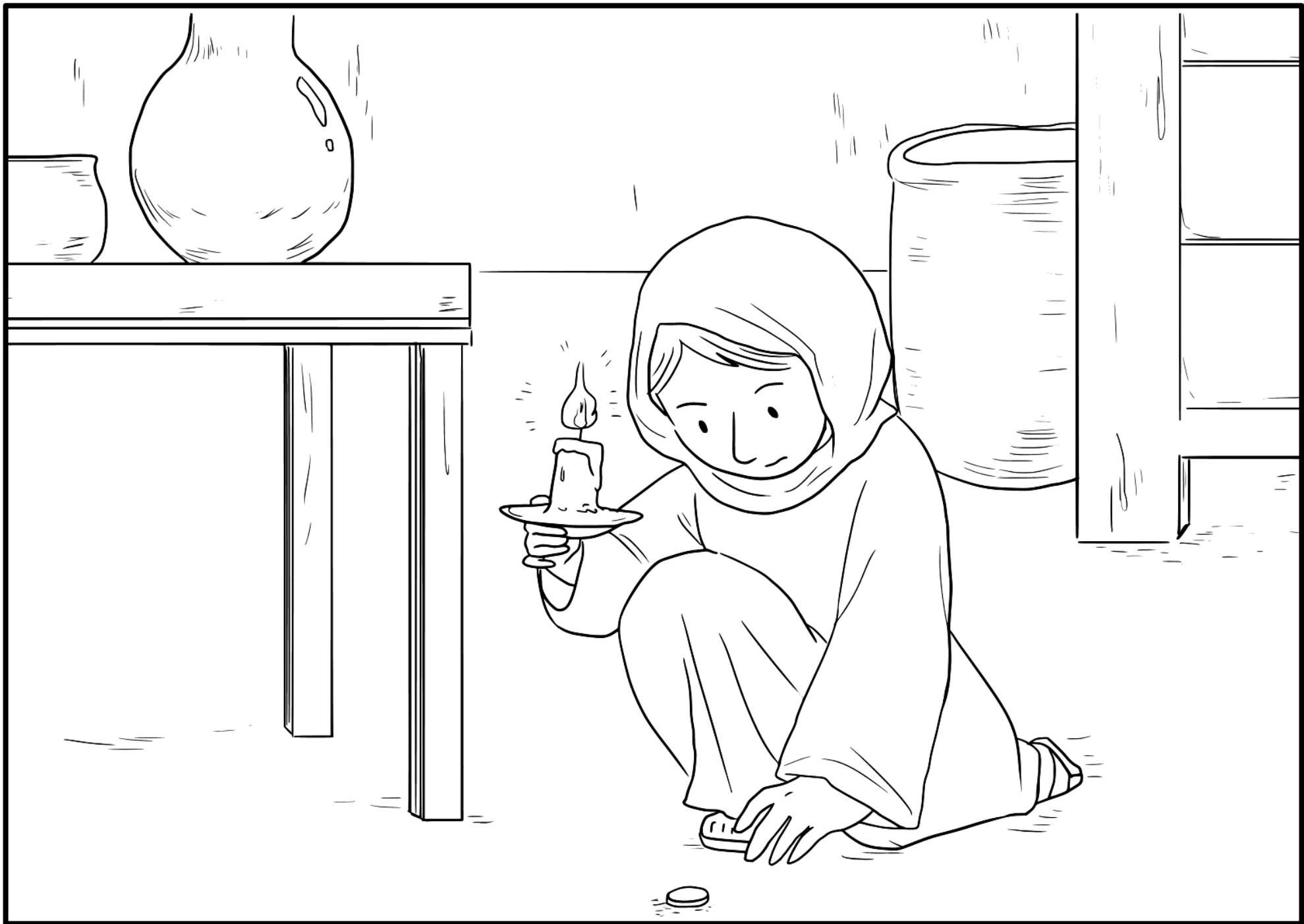
And He spoke to them this parable, saying, what man of you having a hundred sheep, and losing one of them, does not leave the ninety nine in the open and go after the lost one until he finds it

Luke 15:3-4

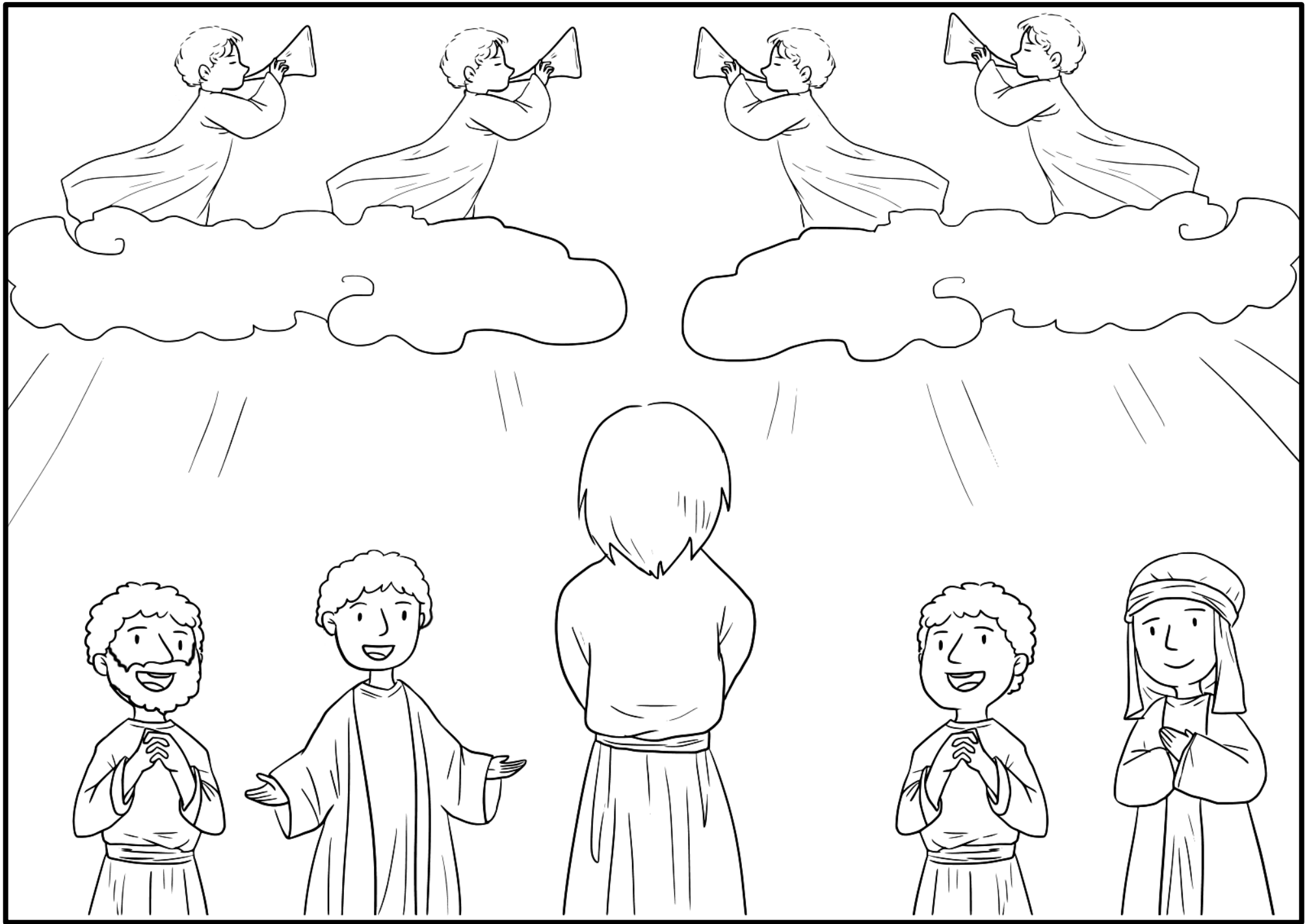
