- Discipleship in Unexpected Ways, a 501(c3) discipleship ministry, is the umbrella program that includes Traveler Journeys, a program to take people on journeys to the Holy Land. We have taken groups to Egypt, Israel, Jordan, and Greece since 2018 to experience the lands of Moses, Jesus, and Paul in unique ways. These trips broaden the faith of believers and expose all to the origins of our faith as no other type of education can.
- We feel that God has called us to reach unbelievers & Christians to grow disciples in nontraditional ways. This travel ministry is a wonderful start & we are developing a training program to give our traveler alumni the tools they need to become stronger disciples then fulfill our calling when they return home.
- We have so many ideas and God whispers to fulfill. We created this tax-exempt ministry to take donations so we can help those with a sincere heart for God & discipleship to be able to take this journey. We do not gift anyone a full tour but we are open to where God leads us with gifting.
- Future plans include formalizing our discipleship program materials, expanding our reach into the community, and supporting more frequent tours to the Holy Land to enable more people to join us.
