

**Bridgehampton Township Regular Meeting
July 8, 2020 7 PM**

Regular meeting for July 8, 2020 was held at Bridgehampton Township Hall Carsonville, Michigan. The meeting was called to order at 07:01 PM by Sonck, welcome, followed by The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Roll call by Sonck, present were: Innes, McCarty, Hewitt, Kelly, and Sonck.

Motion by Hewitt to accept the Agenda with the addition of Introduction of Kyle O'Mara after Treasurer's report and correction of Fire Assessment under New Business, supported by Kelly. All Ayes

Motion by Hewitt to accept the June 10, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented, supported by Innes. All Ayes

Innes read the Treasurer's report into record as of June 30, 2020. General Fund account balance \$2,286.76, Investment account balance \$119,700.37, Tax Checking account balance \$311.12, Tax Savings account balance \$157.10. The balance difference in the General fund and Investment account from June 30, 2019 to June 30, 2020 is +\$5,393.59. Motion by McCarty to accept the Treasurer's report as presented, supported by Kelly. All Ayes

Potential township attorney Kyle O'Mara introduced by current township attorney Tim Wrathell. Mr. O'Mara is from Deckerville, Mi. and has been practicing for 4 years and is in a partnership in Bad Axe, Mi. with Ferris & Schwedler. Mr. O'Mara received his law degree from Cooley Law of Auburn Hills and would charge the township \$140.00 Hr.

Assessor's Report: Mr. Lupo has sent his report in to tax management regarding the AMAR Report and hasn't heard anything back yet. Due to Covid they're working out of their house, so that may have slowed the response. Tuesday July 21, 2020 @ 11:00 AM will be the July Board of Review.

Z.A. Report: Getting land splits in and acquiring more vehicles on the Lapp property. Mr. Dickens would like a notice sent out to all residents regarding blight, before he enforces it. Also, the Land Division Act of 1997 allows for 45 to complete the land division process.

Old Business: Decision to remain in the MTA, who lobby for small government. Motion by Innes to pay the MTA dues for 2020-2021, supported by Hewitt. Roll call vote: Innes yes, McCarty no, Hewitt yes, Kelly yes, and Sonck no. Motion passed 3 yes votes to 2 No.

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New Business: Motion by Sonck to set the Fire Assessment & Drains Hearing for August 12, 2020 at 7 PM, supported by McCarty. All Ayes

Motion by Hewitt to pay the bills numbered 12010-12035 including the MTA dues, supported by Innes. All Ayes

Public Comment: Z.A. Dickens got a letter from the Building Dept. that they're going after a McGregor residence for not meeting building codes.

Assessor Lupo is going to get the board information on a County Assessor.

Motion to Adjourn at 7:51 PM by Hewitt, supported by Innes. All Ayes
