Car Club Membership Cards - Update

CAR CLUB MEMBERSHIP CARDS were introduced by our car club 2 years ago for the purpose of proving membership if requested by Police and for the purpose of receiving discounts from businesses which support our car club, such as Autobarn.

New cards were prepared for our 2022 year, however they were unfortunately printed with the same expiry date as that showing on the members C.ex Coffs membership card. As C.ex Coffs offers the choice of renewing their membership for several years, this meant some car club membership cards were printed with a expiry date beyond our 12 month car club membership.

Those car club members who only renewed their C.ex Coffs memberhip for a year, will be issued with new car club membership cards with an expiry date of 30th June 2022.

I have about 30 car club membership cards with a 30th June 2022 expiry date which I will issue to members at upcoming events and meetings.

A new batch of car club membership cards will be produced for our entire membership base in June 2022 with an expiry date of 30th June 2023 and this process will then follow each year.

Members have been urged to always carry various documentation when using their conditionally registered vehicles such as log books, calendar of club events, proof of membership etc.

Proof of membership is no longer a requirement to drive a conditionally registered vehicle and any person with a current driver's licence is permitted to drive such a vehicle, provided their driver's licence covers the vehicle class. That aside, probably best to carry evidence of club membership rather than debate it with a highway patrol officer.

The only race meetings I went to were Historic Winton in May with the Nota Major which was a mixed bag of disasters, not of my making, and a one day HSRCA Historic meeting at Goulburn in November which was a washout so I came home early after only doing the practice session where I concluded that I was wasting my time because of the conditions.

At least the Grafton hill climb was still running most of the year and I went there on five occasions with five different cars so that all relieved the boredom a bit. The highlight of the year there was the Historic hill climb in June which was very well received and it is scheduled to be run again in 2022, in July I believe.

Fortunately a new and involved restoration project arrived in January which has kept me busy all the year, at the time of writing it is mobile in chassis form, pic above, and the body should be completed by the painter soon so it will be good to see the car complete again after being virtually written off some 67 years ago.

The initial programme for 2022 is to go to the Phillip Island Historics with the Nota Major in March and then Historic Winton in May where I hope to be able to display the "new" car, the Ian Mountain Peugeot Special. In between we should be able get to a few hill climbs at Grafton, one of my favourite venues.

IAN MOUNTAIN PEUGEOT SPECIAL

A story of unfulfilled promise and tragedy; after spending years building the ultimate Peugeot Special it was to claim the life of its creator, Ian Mountain in January 1955 at the Gnoo Blas circuit, Orange, NSW.

The special used a Peugeot 203 engine bored out to 1490ccs which was fed by a huge Wade supercharger driven from the front of the crankshaft and supplied by a 2 3/16 SU carburettor. The chassis comprised two large parallel tubes with a front suspension based on the Peugeot.


At the rear a DeDion setup was used with a cut down Ford V8 differential. The gearbox was MG TC and the driveline was offset to allow a low seating position. The alloy body was built by Neil Coleman and painted an attractive mid blue.

Its first appearance was without the body at a hill climb at Beveridge near Melbourne followed by another at Templestowe. With the body fitted it ran at Fishermen's Bend in October but was troubled by a fuel distribution problem. Next run was at the 1954 AGP at Southport in November where it ran quite well but retired when it lost its coolant.

In January, 1955 it was entered at Gnoo Blas but in its first race there Ian lost control at Connaghan's Corner and left the road sustaining injuries that proved to be fatal.

The car was severely damaged and was taken back to Melbourne. It had been willed to Ian's brother, Ken who commenced a restoration but was unable to complete the project. Eventually it was sold to Harry Firth but no further progress was made and he then sold the car in 1974 to Ian Tate who was working for Harry at the time.

Ian had been gradually gathering together sufficient parts to complete the restoration but passed it on to Dick Willis early in 2021.

<u>PRE-MEETING:</u> Attendees entered the meeting room under Covid -19 guidelines from 10.00am and were recorded on the Car Club Attendance Register, upon entry.

<u>MORNING TEA</u>: An excellent morning tea was provided by the car club and catered for by C.ex Woolgoolga in our meeting room.

PRESIDENT: Opened the AGM at 11.00am, welcomed everyone and called for any apologies.

ATTENDANCE: Total attendance 47, (as per register), including 38 financial members.

CONFIRM MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS AGM AND BUSINESS ARISING

Secretary confirmed a copy of the Minutes of the previous AGM held on 25th October 2020 was included in the October 2021 Car Club Newsletter which was emailed to members on 1st October 2021 and members were encouraged to review those Minutes prior to the AGM. Secretary further advised that as the AGM had to be postponed due to Covid-19, these Minutes were again published in the December 2021 Car Club Newsletter which issued on 29th November 2021.

Secretary advised there was no business arising and moved the Minutes of the previous AGM 25th October 2020 be accepted.

PRESENTATION OF 30th JUNE 2021 AUDIT REPORT

Treasurer displayed a slide showing the Car Club's Annual Audit Report 30th June 2021.

Treasurer commented on the report and asked if there were any questions from the floor.

No questions were received.

Treasurer moved the Car Club's Audit Report 30th June 2021 be accepted. Seconded by: Peter Thomson

ELECTION OF COMMITTEE

Secretary requested the Car Club's appointed Returning Officer, Dick Willis, to take the chair and directed all existing Committee Members and Office Bearers to now stand down.

RETURNING OFFICER - DICK WILLIS

"Welcome everyone to the C.ex Coffs Sports Touring & Classic Car Club 2021 AGM.

My name is Dick Willis. I am a financial member of the C.ex Coffs Sports Touring & Classic Car Club and have been appointed as the Returning Officer for the 2022 Committee elections. As Returning Officer, I am not eligible to be nominated for any positions in this election.

- A "Notice of AGM" was included in the October 2021 Car Club Newsletter and a further "AGM Update" was included in the November 2021 Car Club Newsletter, advising a change of date for the meeting. The following information has also been provided through these two Newsletters, as required under the C.ex Coffs "Rules For Operation";
- 1. Advice of date, time and venue for the 2021 AGM.
- 2. Nomination Forms for Committee and Office Bearer positions and directions on completion and return.
- 3. Agenda details, Covid-19 Rules Applying and The Importance of the AGM and Elections.

The Car Club is required, under the C.ex Coffs "Rules for Operation", to fill the following minimum number of positions in order for the Car Club to operate as a Sub-Club of C.ex Coffs,

President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and up to 4 other Committee Members".

I now declare all positions vacant, however before I announce the nominations received, I ask for any further nominations from the floor.

As no further nomination were received from the floor, the Returning Officer requested the Secretary to display a slide showing the nominations received. All supporting documentation is held by the Secretary.

The returning Officer then read from the slide confirming each individual Nominee, Proposer and Seconder for the positions of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Returning Officer then commented;

"As Returning Officer, I hereby declare the nominees shown on the display as duly elected to their respective positions and asks the meeting to congratulate the new Committee".

"I would like to thank the outgoing Committee and Officer Bearers for their contribution to our club over the past year. Two members of the 2021 Committee Group gave prior notice they would not be standing for re-election in 2022 and I would like to especially thank them individually for their contributions also. They are Club President David Kennedy and Welfare Officer Bill Denham".

"Thank you for your attendance and participation at the $2021\,AGM$ and I wish the Car Club well in 2022".

Returning Officer moved the 2021 AGM election process be accepted as completed as required by C.ex Coffs Seconded by: Patrick Mathon

No objections to the appointments were received and confirmation was considered unanimous

<u>SECRETARY:</u> Thanked the Returning Officer for his assistance and declared the Election of Committee process complete. <u>PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CLUB BY-LAWS</u>

A majority vote by the members in attendance is necessary for the amendments to be submitted to the C.ex Coffs Board for formal approval.

Existing By-Law 4 states;

Members must provide copies of their H/D registration papers to the Club President, on initial registration and on renewal. This document must be provided to the President within seven (7) days of the registration date, for recording in the H/D plate register.

Non-compliance of this By-Law will be seen as a contravention of the By-Laws and disciplinary action may be taken by the C.ex Coffs Board of Directors.

Proposed Amendment to By-Law 4;

Members must provide copies of their Conditional Registration Papers for vehicles under both the Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS) and the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS) to the <u>Club Registration Administrator</u>, on initial registration and on renewal. This document must be provided to the <u>Club Registration Administrator</u> within seven (7) days of the registration date, for recording in the HVS and CVS plate register.

This is a compliance obligation our club has to C.ex Coffs and it would be appreciated if all members assisted by strictly observing this condition.

Proposed Addition To Club By-Laws (New Item 6)

Registration Administrators and Registration Inspectors are <u>not authorised</u> to complete, sign off on, or process, any documentation in relation to conditional registration for vehicles where they are the registered owner.

Proposed amendment to By-Law 4 was seconded by Peter Thomson and the addition of a new By-Law (6) was seconded by Davis Kennedy

No objections were raised from the floor and confirmation was considered unanimous.

SECRETARY

If there are no further comments from the floor, I declare the 2022 AMG closed at 12.05pm_and request the new Club President to take the chair and open the December General Meeting.

The December General Meeting followed (separate minutes will be prepared) and included the usual Club Raffle. Around 30 members stayed on for lunch which was catered for by Buster's Bistro and served in the meeting room.
