#### **ELM PARK'S RACECOURSE GALLOP - NOT IMPRESSIVE**

Classic contender Elm Park worked after racing. He was very fit and looked well. Very relaxed / bright in the pre-parade ring with a group of horses (also some from Eve Johnson Houghton). One of his workmates looked much better, however, but as always the trainer would not tell the press the name of that horse. It was another bay, with a white blaze and long white socks on both hind legs. He was very fit, very shiny.

This companion worked much better than Elm Park in my opinion. A trio set off with a lead horse (of lesser quality) making the running ahead of Elm Park, with the horse mentioned sitting last of the three a few lengths behind Elm Park. Ridden by Oisin Murphy, he moved up to join Elm Park at the finish, and seemed hard held not to go by the G1 winner. He also galloped out much better than Elm Park.

Jockey Andrea Atzeni looked disappointed after the gallop. The ground was probably too firm for the Racing Post Trophy winner – but I have my doubts about this colt now. He has filled out and looks strong and scopey but perhaps he hasn't trained on. I remember seeing him here on his debut, when he was already extremely fit (before being sold) and his juvenile campaign may have been quite a hard one. **GS**
