Want some free Bible software - and what is Bible software? Well, Accordance Bible Software have a very basic version free. They call it Accordance Lite and you can download it at accordancebible.com.

So, download it and have a look. See their videos and seminars. Explore their resources, and if you think it's worth trying it a bit more, there's a sale offer now.

The "Basic Starter" collection is US dollars 24.90 compared to the usual 59.90 until 4 May.

There's a "Catholic Studies Add-On Bundle" that's worth looking at: it includes extra Bibles (NABRE, NJB,NRSVS, Catholic Bible Study Notes, Catholic Catechism, Canon Law, Vatican I and II and more.

That costs 119 USD reduced from 174 USD.

So Accordance Lite is free.

Also free: I'll give a Basic Starter collection (before 4 May!) to the first person who tells me they want one: try out the free version first to see if you want something more. Send an email to the parish office with your details and the one that arrives first should get a copy. By the way,
