- Q. How are we made right with God?
- A. 34. We are accounted righteous before God only because of the merit of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, applied by faith, and not for our own works or merits. And this righteousness, which we so receive of God's mercy and Christ's merits, embraced by faith, is taken, accepted, and allowed of God, for our perfect and full justification.

God Calls His People to Repentance

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:8–9)

God's People Confess Their Sin

Almighty God to Whom all hearts are open and from Whom no secrets are hid. You brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus Christ in triumph over the grave and in a mighty display of Your grace; we confess that we are unworthy of Your grace. We too quickly doubt Your promises, and are too easily turned from You, our living Lord. The world has enticed us, blinding us to Christ's presence, dulling us to the power of His Word. We forget the good news of His true victory over sin and death, and have used our own forgetfulness as an excuse to sin. But now we come to You, utterly helpless and entirely dependent on Your steadfast love, and ask for Your forgiveness. In Your mercy, cleanse us. In Your love, heal us.

And by Your grace, restore to us the joy of Your salvation. In Jesus' Name we pray.


