TOAST OF NEW YORK was second to Shared Belief in the Pacific Classic (G1), without doubt putting up his career best. He comes back from England to have another crack, and it will be interesting to see how he fares on the dirt. He showed good tactical speed when winning a sub-standard edition of the UAE Derby (G2) over nine at Meydan back in March, and raced prominently also in the Pacific Classic. This will be his fourth long haul trip of the year, as he also ran in the Belmont Derby (G1) on turf at Belmont Park in June, finishing rather a tame fifth behind Mr Speaker. The son of Thewayouare was a bit under a cloud when returning home after that race.
