Dang Yankee

Khediye Clown Brandon Smith, a.k.a. “Dang Yankee”, grew up in a boys home in Abbottstown, Pennsylvania. The young boys were fortunate enough to get opportunities to go see the Zembo Shrine Circus in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Brandon Smith, after being given the gift of laughter and cheer from the Zembo Shrine Clowns at the yearly circus, decided at an early age that he wanted to be a Shrine Clown.

At the September 2022 Khediye Shrine business meeting, Brandon Smith was one of seven new Nobles voted on and obligated that evening. Two weeks later, Brandon attended his first Khediye Clown Unit meeting and was voted a member of the Khediye Clown Unit, a childhood dream realized. Brandon and fellow ‘new’ clown Corey Parker, marched in their first parade on November 5, 2022 in the Urbana Virginia Oyster Festival Parade.

Brandon could have just coasted and enjoyed realizing his childhood dream of being a Shrine Clown. But that’s not who we are and that’s not who he is. Because of his childhood experiences, Brandon has a particular soft spot for disadvantaged children. Brandon created and is chairing the Clown Unit Outreach Committee.

For his first outing, Brandon Smith contacted Newport News Virginia Juvenile Services. Through multiple conversations, emails and meetings, he was able to coordinate and set up an opportunity for the Khediye Clown Unit to help with the 2022 Newport News Juvenile Detention Center Christmas party. Three clowns and two of their ladies were able to bring some holiday cheer to the staff, approximately 50 children and their parents by providing snacks, gift bags for the children and, most importantly smiles.

The two Shriners’ Children’s Hospitals that Khediye Shrine supports, Greenville, SC and Philadelphia, PA are 7 hours and 5 hours away, respectively, from Khediye Shrine Center. Brandon’s huge heart and empathy led him and the Khediye Clowns to provide smiles and cheer to an entirely different group of children, children that are often overlooked and neglected. The Khediye Clowns are looking forward to other outreach opportunities in their area in 2023 and are thankful to have Brandon “Dang Yankee” to lead those efforts.
