Mark's Thoughts

God Can't Really Mean That!

As the Apostle Paul winds down his first letter to the church at Thessalonica he concludes chapter 5 with a series of Gospel imperatives including in verse 18 "give thanks in all circumstances for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." My immediate reaction to an imperative like that runs along the lines of; "Sounds good but hardly possible." That way I'm off the hook because God can't really mean that. So I can file that with all of the other things God says but does not mean!

Along with many of you I have watched some of the reports dealing with the destruction Harvey left behind in Texas. A piece of an interview grabbed my attention. A woman standing waist deep in water with a trash bag of possessions over her shoulder said, "God is so good! God is so awesome!" Obviously she understood the imperative in "Give thanks in all circumstances!"

What prompted such a statement? The backdrop for the news story was rescue efforts undertaken by volunteers. Kudos to the woman who recognized God's love amid the chaos. She recognized it because other people practiced it.


