Her proposal came with standard factory warranty but recommended purchase of 3-year warranty for \$200 and 1000va battery backup for additional \$145. Company's hourly rate was \$125. Since she had not spoken with anyone at city offices, she was unable to estimate labor hours.

John Motazech with SNC², presented quote for \$2,641 for HP with 12g hard drive, \$1,320 for software and \$2,000 for labor at \$100 per hour for estimated 20 hours. He had loaner available, but would have to order system with delivery on Monday.

Motion made by Frank Herron, seconded by Dale Daniels, to accept S&S Computer bid for \$4,139.98. Ayes: Aldermen Daniels, Herron. Nays: Aldermen Daugherty, Bone. Mayor broke tie and voted in favor. Motion carried.

Court and Police Departments were kept separate. Motion made by Roger Bone, seconded by Lisa Daugherty, to have bidders meet with Chief Kitch to discuss PD needs as preventative measure. Ayes: Aldermen Daniels, Herron, Daugherty, Bone. Nays: none. Motion carried.
