Re: Senate Passes Bill To End Civil Commitment of Sex Offenders - and Preventive Detention in Avenel, NJ

This communication is in regards to our previous correspondence that was sent to your office and to update you on our "We the People Petition Our Government TO DEMAND AN EXECUTIVE ORDER AND SENATE BILL/ with SIGNATURES for an executive Order and Senate Bill". This new legislation would end civil commitment of sex offenders by 2022 SESSION.

We the people have enclosed information, about our goal to reach 100.000 plus signatures for lawmakers to spearhead a push to repeal a decades-old New Jersey law that allows the state to hold certain sex offenders at the STU facility indefinitely after their criminal sentences, if they are deemed "sexually violent predators".
