DIRECTIONS FROM PITTSBURGH:

Follow I279-S toward the Fort Pitt bridge/airport.

Merge onto I376-W and go through the Fort Pitt tunnel.

Take the 1st exit after the tunnel (69-A) for US19-S/Banksville Rd (as you exit, be careful to follow the signs for Banks-ville Rd/US19. DO NOT get back on the parkway!)



Get in your one-horse open sleigh and join us for the potluck party!

About 2.5 miles down Banksville, bear right at the Y onto Beverly Rd. Follow Beverly for 0.7 miles.

At the T intersection, turn right on Cochran Rd.

Go about 500 feet and make the second left onto Scrubgrass Rd.

Turn left at the first stop sign onto Old Hickory Road. #949 is the next to last house on the right.

Music Education Evaluations

This year's music education evaluations will be held on 12 February, 2011 and 12 March, 2011 in room A-12 of the College of Fine Arts at Carnegie Mellon University. Adjudicators for the sessions will be announced in an upcoming newsletter.

Each participant will have 10 minutes to perform 2 pieces of contrasting style (etudes are also acceptable), and then will have 5 minutes to speak with the adjudicators. Comments are based on tone, interpretation, memory, rhythm, and stage presence.

For the second session, participants will play the same two pieces and a third piece may be added. Participants are to bring the comments they received at the first session to the second session. A written theory test will also be given.

This is not a competition—no prizes will be awarded. The focus is on IMPROVEMENT between the first and second sessions.

Registration forms will be sent out by 8 January 2010. The deadline to register is **1 February 2010.**
