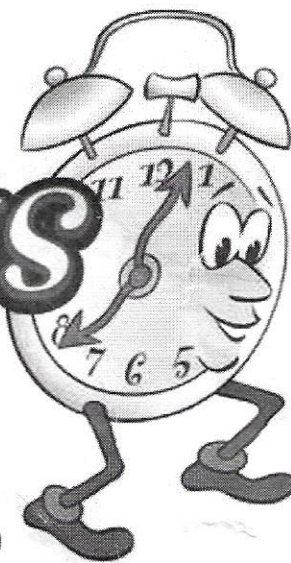
I & I Ladies Auxiliary Meeting

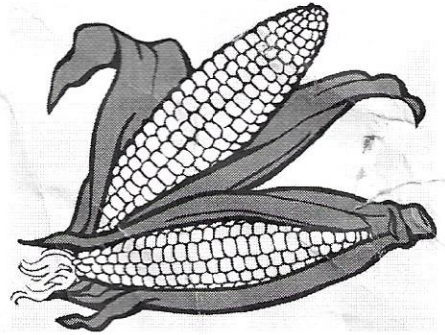

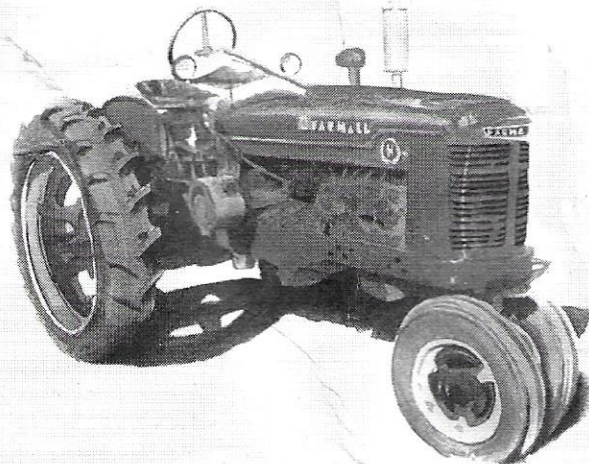
