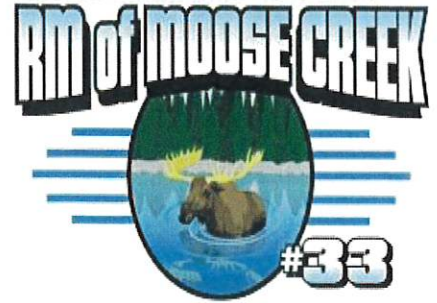

MCCAULEY BRIDGE



The McCauley Bridge was completed in June to replace the collapsed crossing that was closed in 2011 due to flood damage. This bridge will shorten the routes many producers have to currently take to access their land.

2022 Road Construction Update: the RIRG Grant was received for 50% funding of clay clapping 6.4 kms, East of 03,10-4-02 W2M and North of 10-4-2 W2M, also known as the Park Road. The tender was awarded to Shaw Earth Moving, Gainsborough.

Water Well Tokens: The RM has two wells located within the Municipality boundaries, and one shared well located within the RM of Reciprocity. To access the two wells located at:

1. SW 17-05-03 W2M, and
2. SE 01-06-02 W2M

Water tokens are available for pickup at the office. \$40/year for ratepayers only and \$100/year for commercial usage.

Notary Public and Commissioner of Oaths services are available to ratepayers at no charge (\$20.00 charge for non-ratepayers)

Gravel for ratepayers at a cost of \$16.00/yard is being offered at a maximum of 3 loads a year. If you would like to be added to the list please contact the office to fill out a custom work form.

Building/Moving in a shop or home please remember that you need to obtain a development permit for all permanent structures or additions to permanent structures from the RM office. The cost is \$100, and the form is on the website, can be emailed to you, or picked up at the office.
