Rules relating to the QBRA Futurity / Maturity

The QBRA Futurity / Maturity is being run in conjunction with advertised QBRA events.

- 1. All horses must be registered with the QBRA prior to running at its first event.
- 2. No individual entry fee will apply, a single fee at the time of registration of \$50 will apply and must be paid to the QBRA before points will be allocated. Points will not be backdated to previous events.
- 3. Futurity Horse is classed as a horse that is either 4, 5 or 6 years of age as at the 1st competition event of the current year.
- 4. Maturity Horse is classed as a horse that is either 7, 8 or 9 years of age as at the 1st competition event of the current year.
- 5. Points will be allocated from the results of the event, in the case of a rider only competing in the juniors, their times will be added into the open results. If a rider competes in both Opens and Juniors at a single event the placing will be given from their **OPEN** time.
- 6. Points are awarded on an outright contest basis of 1st to 5th with Maximum, Minimum or half points being applied to events.
- 7. Futurity and Maturity points will be allocated from all points events on the QBRA calendar.
- 8. Riders must be able to provide registration certificate, or 'Proof of Age Certificate' signed by veterinarian as proof of horses' age at all events and at any time when requested by promoter. (N.B. To avoid issues, bring proof documentation with you when registering your horse).
