

TREASURER'S REPORT





As of our December Executive Meeting, total YTD expenses are \$20,043 while total YTD income is \$39,141. Major expenses that have occurred since our last newsletter include \$1,636 for 5th grade shirts (offset 100% by income for sale of the shirts), \$533 for K-3 Movie Night (offset by \$482 in ticket sales), \$571 in Classroom Enrichment to the teachers and \$377 in Communications/ Copies cost for newsletter printing. The significant sources of income since our last newsletter include \$266 from

eScrip and \$156 from Flyer Nights. We are excited about the financial status of your PTA so far this year and we are excited about the 2nd half of our fiscal year. With our upcoming 1st annual Auction Fundraiser and several Community events still to come (including the Father Daughter Dance and Mother and Son activity), your continued support is appreciated and extremely valuable to the many programs your PTA continues to provide. WOULD YOU KNOW IF SOMEONE WAS HAVING AN ALLERGIC REACTION TO A FOOD???

An allergic reaction to food can affect the skin, the gastrointestinal tract, the respiratory tract, and, in the most serious cases, the cardiovascular system.

The most common food allergy signs and symptoms include:

- Tingling or itching in the mouth
- Hives, itching or eczema
- Swelling of the lips, face, tongue and throat or other parts of the body
- Wheezing, nasal congestion or trouble breathing
- Abdominal pain, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
- Dizziness, lightheadedness or fainting

In some people, a food allergy can trigger a severe allergic reaction called anaphylaxis. This can cause life-threatening signs and symptoms, including:

- Constriction and tightening of airways
- A swollen throat or the sensation of a lump in your throat that makes it difficult to breathe
- Shock with a severe drop in blood pressure
- Rapid pulse
- Dizziness, lightheadedness or loss of consciousness

Emergency treatment is critical for anaphylaxis and the most effective treatment for an anaphylactic reaction is epinephrine (epi-pen or Auvi-Q device). A delay in treatment and anaphylaxis can cause a coma or even death. For additional information, go to www.foodallergy.org/symptoms.


