January Meeting Information: Dog Tree Swap & Member Workshop

We will have our first meeting of the year on January 11th, 2020, at 10 AM at a new location. We will be meeting in Room LV2200. There is plenty of parking directly across the street from the building.

We will be having our "Dog Tree Swap" program. If you have not participated before, it is your chance to bring a tree that you have given up on or just don't know what to do with, or any excess tree that you have, and "swap" it for one that another member has brought. The basic rules are:

1. Each person can bring up to three trees.

2. Each tree will be assigned a number and each member will get a number for each tree that they bring.

3. All numbers will be put in a drawing box, and each member will get to select a tree from all of the trees available when their number is drawn. 4. Drawing continues until all trees are taken.

5. Trees must be alive and healthy. Please do not bring any infected, diseased, or dead trees.

- 6. Trees can be in nursery pots or bonsai pots.
- 7. If you wish to bring more than 3 trees, the

excess trees will be put in the club raffle.

8. Come with an open mind. Another person's "junk" could be your "treasure".

We will also talk about this year's schedule. We have "open" dates in September and October and would like to bring in a guest speaker to do a demonstration and workshop.
