

FAQ'S Eyelash Extensions

What are Eyelash Extensions?

Eyelash extensions are semi-permanent fibers that are attached to your natural eyelashes in order to make your lash fringe look longer, fuller, and darker. Individual lash extensions are applied to each of your individual natural eyelashes (one extension per natural eyelash) using a semi-permanent glue.

How Long Does Lash Extensions Application Take?

It can take anywhere from 2-3 hours when getting a full set. A fill (touch-up) can take up to an hour or two.

How Long do Lash Extensions Last?

Generally, 2-4 weeks. The touch-ups are needed every two to three weeks, depending on the growth of the natural lashes.

Will Eyelash Extensions Ruin My Natural Lashes?

The biggest myth is that lash extensions ruin your own lashes. They do not. They are safe and do not ruin the health of your natural lashes. Be sure not to rub your eyes or tug or pull on the extensions because this can cause lash loss and even damage to your natural lashes.

What To Avoid When Getting Eyelash Extensions On?

For the first 48 hours after application, avoid taking a shower, washing your eyes, or getting your eyelash extensions wet. Water can affect the glue, causing the bond to become brittle and easy to break.

What Does Eyelash Extension Aftercare Involve?

- Don't get wet for 48 hours after application
- Wash them regularly (every 2-3 days)
- Brush lashes out twice a day (Morning & Night) with dry spoolie

Eyelash Extensions After Care

- 1. Clean eyelashes with foam cleanser every 1-2 days.
- 2. Brush through your eyelash tips in the morning.
- 3. Avoid sleeping on your face.
- 4. Avoid touching and rubbing lashes.
- 5. Do not pull on lashes (This can cause your natural eyelash to fall out with the extension).
- 6. Avoid oil and moisture around the lashes.
