

Introduction

Following the decision of Her Majesty's Government (HMG) and the Welsh Assembly Government (WAG) to institute a 'lockdown' of the United Kingdom on 23rd March 2020 and the various Welsh Assembly instructed lockdowns since, the fishery has been closed for most of the last 12 months.

During our planned phased release from the latest lockdown (which came in to force on 20th December 2020) the fishery guiding principles will be to:

- 1. Do everything necessary to ensure that the health of anglers, visitors and our staff is protected, and
- 2. Minimise the potential for the transfer of the virus by fully complying with all directives and guidance.

Rest assured we will not compromise on these guiding principles.

Anyone not prepared to adopt a similar position should look to fish somewhere other than here at Tan-y-Mynydd.

Executive Summary

If you have recently been diagnosed with COVID-19 or suspect you are displaying its symptoms then please self-isolate and do NOT compromise the safety of yourself or others by trying to book a slot with us. As part of the booking process you will be required to confirm that you are clear of COVID-19 and its symptoms. If on arrival or at any time whilst on site we suspect you may be infected you will be asked to leave.

We recognise that there are families who come fishing at Tan-y-Mynydd and as such we wish to continue to welcome them. In order that we can accommodate small family groups / bubbles and any extended bubble where people have exclusively isolated together, it is vital that anyone travelling to the fishery must do so in strictly in accordance with the rules applicable to Wales. Any failure to adhere to the those rules will unfortunately result in access to the fishery being denied, without a refund.

The table below details how we plan to return gradually back to whatever the 'new normal' looks like. The TWO critical things anglers need to do are as follows:

- 1. Ensure you are pre-booked in with the fishery. <u>REMEMBER:</u> No pre-booked Slot = No Access to the Fishery (Applies to Phases 1 to 3 inclusive)
- 2. Abide by WAG & HMG guidelines plus our rules and we will all get along fine. If you cannot agree to abiding by our rules and national guidelines then please do NOT come to Tan-y-Mynydd
