

#### **Club Rules**

All birds must be penned before 10.30am (The pavilion will be open 8am show day. Please let us know if you need to get in at other times. Contact Bryan on 0415303464)

1. Entry fees must accompany all entries, and the entry form must be filled and returned.

2. Sick or injured birds will not be accepted for judging.

3. The committee will take every care but no responsibility for loss or damage to any bird.

4. The judges' decision with regards to awarding or rejecting any bird is final.

5. No birds may be removed from their pen by any person unless under the supervision of the chief steward or their delegate.

A class shall consist a minimum of 6 birds and 2 breeders except the 'premier 3' – Dark, Light and Partridge. Three new classes have replaced certain classes to reflect the new standards and their colours, and to alleviate big numbers in the AOC class. New classes are Columbian AC (All Colours), Self Colour AC, and Barred AC. See below for the breakdown of these new classes. The committee reserves the right to create, group or eliminate a class when necessary. **Please clearly indicate the colour and type of all birds on the entry form.** 



THE "PREMIER 3" CLASSES

Partridge includes Gold and Blue Gold

## All Other Classes

Columbian AC (All Colours) includes Blue Light, Buff, Blue Buff, and White Buff.

Self Colour AC includes White, Black, Buff, and Blue.

Barred AC includes Barred, Cuckoo, Buff Cuckoo, Barred Light, Barred Buff Columbian, Golden Crele, and Silver Crele.

**AOC** (All Other Colours) includes Chamois, Salmon, Splash, Speckled and others.
