

◆◆◆ The Abomination of Desolation ◆◆◆ is already in Jerusalem

Meaning: It is something that makes Jerusalem desolate (uninhabited by the Messianic Hebrew believers in Messiah Jesus).

◆ **Daniel 10:1**

In the third year of Cyrus = 533 BC

◆ **Daniel 12:11**

“From the time the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that makes desolate is set up, there shall be 1290 days.”

Jesus spoke of the Abomination of Desolation in Mark 13:14

◆ **Mark 13:14 “But, when you shall see the Abomination of Desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet standing where “it” ought not, (let him that reads understand,) then let them that be in Judea flee to the mountains.”**

The words of Jesus says “it” and not he. The Greek uses a neuter pronoun. Greek has masculine, feminine, and neuter pronouns. Therefore, this does not describe an Antichrist but a demonic object or symbol of domination and also the expulsion of the faithful believers from Jerusalem.

Notice also that the disciples fled Jerusalem at the time when Vespasian and Titus were pillaging the region of Jerusalem. They fled to Pella which is mountainous east

of the Jordan river. Pella is in Jordan now. Josephus stated that the disciples remembered what Jesus told them and fled before Titus besieged Jerusalem. Actually, Vespasian was in the process of sieging and destroying Jerusalem, but YHWH God gave the disciples and the Apostles a brief pause to enable all the Messianic believers to escape and flee from Jerusalem to Pella: Nero died in AD 68 and Vespasian suspended his campaigns against Jerusalem to gather political clout of the Roman generals in Alexandria and in Syria which allowed him to become the new emperor of Rome. Then he charged his son Titus to destroy Jerusalem and Titus placed the Abomination of Desolation, i.e., the Roman gods on the Temple Mount (Mount Moriah).

606 BC Daniel was taken captive along with other Jews by Nebuchednezzar. That was the first year of Nebuchednezzar.

586 BC Nebuchednezzar returned to Jerusalem and destroyed the Temple.

562 BC was the end of Nebuchednezzar rule in Babylon. Three of his sons succeeded him.

539 BC Nabonidus became the King of Babylon. Nabonidus was less of a governor and more of a religious man.

538 BC Baltshazar the son of Nabonidus ruled Babylon while his father went to Uruk and other religious temples to worship his gods.

536 BC Daniel was offered to become the “Third King” of

Babylon after he interpreted the dream of Baltshazar because Baltshazar was the “Second King” while Nabonidus was the “Father (First) King” at the same time.

536 BC Cyrus took over Babylon and appointed his general Darius. Cyrus went back to rule Persia, the Medes, and Babylon Great Empire.

533 BC Both Cyrus and Darius decreed the return of the Jews. But, Darius decreed that they can go back and rebuild the streets and the walls. Therefore, the Decree mentioned in the other prophecy of Daniel (the Seventy Weeks) refers to the decree of Darius not of Cyrus.

533 BC The 1290 days vision of Daniel was given to him.

✧ **Daniel 12:11** begins counting the 1290 days from the ceasing of the sacrifices and the erection of the idol of the abomination of desolation.

✧ **Jeremiah 41:5** was written ten months after the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem. It proves that while the Temple of Jerusalem was destroyed by Nebuchednezzar in 586 BC, yet the sacrifices and the offerings continued in Jerusalem without the Temple Walls.

583 BC Jeremiah 52:30 was written in the twenty-third year of the reign of Nebuchednezzar. It describes that Nebuchednezzar carried 745 Jews (Levites) and all were 4600 Jews who were in Jerusalem. Hence the sacrifices were not ceased yet.

583 BC is the exact time when there was no more daily sacrifices in Jerusalem as the Levites and the remaining Jews were taken to Babylon.

Therefore, the counting of the 1290 days (1290 years) begins at 583 BC.

When you count the years (Hebrew years are 360 days) from 583 BC, you end up in the year 688 AD.

688 AD is the year when the Muslim ruler Kaliphah Omar began building the Dome of the Rock or the El Aqsa Mosque. Omar declared that he is building a Memorial for Mohammed on the Temple Mount, the Holy Place in Jerusalem.

The Dome of the Rock is the Abomination that makes desolate (Abomination of Desolation).

Since that time, Jerusalem and the Temple Mount were declared Muslim land. The Messianic Hebrews and Jews were not allowed to claim the Temple Mount their own.

1976 AD General Moshe Dyan conquered the Temple Mount, but gave it back to the Muslims again within few days due to politics. Moshe Dyan, Ariel Sharon, Rothschild, Ben Gorion, Rockefeller, Mehaem Began, and other politicians in Israel are Ashkenazim. They reject their Savior, the Messiah Jesus Christ.

When Jesus spoke to the Jews of His time, they were Hebrews and Messianic believers (Nazarene - The Way - Yeshua's Disciples) who believed on Him. Jesus called the Hebrew rabbis of his time, sons of the Devil.

Therefore, let us understand that these prophecies are focused only:

- (1) on Jerusalem, and
- (2) on the true believers (the Messianic believers) who are born again through the Blood of Messiah Jesus Christ.

Calculation

✧ How to calculate the 1290 days of Daniel? ✧

1290 years x 360 Hebrew year days = 464400 days
according to the Hebrew Calendar

464400 days / 365.25 solar year days = 1271.46 solar
years

Beginning year = 583 BC

1271 solar year - 583 years = 688.46 AD
which is exactly the year Kaliphah Omar began building
the Abomination of Desolation and the Muslims took hold
of the Temple Mount.

◆◆◆ WHY? ◆◆◆

Why do Christians and Messianic Jews, who believe in
