Chaplaincy Care held their annual training and Vision Banquet of 16 January. The training provided an overview of the Core Value Index program now used by C2 Chaplains to assist First Responders in the various areas of relationships, resiliency, and trauma clearing. The vision for C2 for 2021 is to grow the Chaplaincy Corps for the HCPS-Security, enhance the CVI training platform, and to increase our impacts this year for the Military, both active duty and Retired.

Chaplaincy Care Counseling Center (C4):

We continue to move forward in the 3 to 5-year plan of development and resourcing for the C2 Counseling Center. C4 is excited to have our newest member of the team, Lee West, come on as an additional counselor for our heroes and their families. He will begin seeing clients in February.

Chaplaincy care Academy:

The primary thrust for 2021 is to train and build a proactive and progressive C2 Chaplain’s corps. The main concentration will be with HCPS-Security Chaplains and Largo Fire Rescue Chaplains. There were 6 CH 101 student for this month and 3 CH 201 students.
