OUR HELP (A Meditational Moment)

- I. Who and where is our help? The Holy Scriptures provide us the answers to these questions.
- A. Psalm 46:1-5 conveys "The Lord is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early."
- B. Psalm 108:12-13 declares; "Give us help from trouble, For the help of man is useless. Ps 108:13 Through God we will do valiantly, For it is He who shall tread down our enemies.
- C. Psalm 121:1-2 says, "I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth."
- D. Psalm 124:8 proclaims; "Our help is in the name of the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth."
- F. Matthew 11:28-30 says; "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
- II. How does the Lord help His children?

The Lord Hides His children.

The Lord Envelopes His children.

The Lord Lifts His children.

The Lord Preserves His children.

- A. We know He hides His children because Psalms 27:5 declares; "For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me."
- B. We know He envelopes His children because, Psalm 121:5-6 tells us, "The Lord is your keeper; The Lord is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, Nor the moon by night."
- C. We know He lifts His children because Psalm 27:5-6 states; "He shall set me high upon a rock. And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord."
- D. We know He preserves His children because Psalm 121:7-8 conveys, "The Lord shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in From this time forth, and even forevermore."
