

COVID-19 Guidelines for Safety and Protection – Mi Casa ASC

- Mask wearing is strongly recommended and regular Hand washing/Drying and sanitising will take place on entrance to the programme, before and after eating, before and after use of equipment and on exiting the premises.
- **Food Hygiene and distribution. Gloves and hair nets will be used**. Only one staff member to prepare and serve food. Benches and equipment to be cleaned before preparation. Children to line up and use social distancing rules to collect food.
- Collection of children and sign-out will be monitored. Contactless QR Code sign in/out will be mandatory for all Parents/Caregivers collecting children, QR Code will be displayed at the entrance of the Church. Please note: there will be also the government Covid 19 QR Code displayed at entrance and exit of premises (you will need the Ministry of Health App to scan this code) Collection point will be at the entrance of the church by the carpark at the front, and a staff member will ensure the children are brought to the entrance and sign out will be done there.
- There is a strict **one person per toilet policy at all times**. Monitoring of hand washing will be managed appropriately.
- Low-contact activities and acceptable social distancing rules will be monitored at all times.
- Cleaning of premises and equipment will be done daily.
- Contact Tracing will be monitored by displaying Mi Casa ASC Ministry
 of Health Covid 19 QR Code and by keeping a register of all people who
 enter the facilities.
